

Talent Academy Hardship Fund

England Hockey and the Area Hockey Associations in partnership with the Talent Academies have established a hardship fund to encourage and support the progression of young players from less advantaged backgrounds to be able to access Talent Academy provision with either partial or full fee subsidies.

Awards

Hardship Awards will be given out to players up to the value of £1500. The value of the award may change at the discretion of the Awards Panel. Players can request hardship funding once per season (1 September to 31 August).

Eligibility for Awards

Awards are intended to support players where finance is a barrier for them to access a Talent Academy. The following criteria is in place to better understand an applicant's context and is not to hinder potential applicants from applying or receiving awards.

- Awards are accessible only to those players in **full time**, **state funded education** or are a recipient of a 100% scholarship from a fee-paying school.
- This fund is **not** accessible to individuals who are deemed to be financially capable of / or have the means to fund their involvement in hockey.

Provision of Awards

Players (or their guardians if U18) should apply for an award via their respective Talent Academy manager. (We recommend that applicants speak with the Talent Academy Manager prior to applying).

Applications will be considered by an Awards Panel consisting of:

- Talent Academy Manager
- A combination of Area, County and or England Hockey Representative

The Talent Academy Manager may request further information to support the application.

The decision of the panel will be final. (Please note with partial or full fee awards the respective Talent Academy will deduct the amount from the overall cost rather than transfer funds to the applicant.)

Sustainability of Hardship Awards

It is expected that the Talent Academy Hardship Fund will be available for the foreseeable future. However, England Hockey and the Area Associations reserve the right to withdraw the scheme at any time.
