

Case study: WOMEN'S EUROPEAN HOCKEY CLUB CUP

In May 2018, the club hosted the Women's European Hockey Club Cup - hockey's version of football's Champions League. With eight of Europe's elite club teams in action alongside an Under 14 European Cup, and exhibition matches for Hockey 4 Heroes and Flyerz (para) Hockey, the event was a resounding success for women's sport, English club hockey and the local community.
